5. Fair Play and Competition:

- Abide by the rules and regulations of the game.
- Accept both victories and defeats graciously.
- Do not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct, cheating, or gamesmanship.

6. Dress Code:

- Follow the club's dress code policy, if applicable, during club events and matches.
- Wear appropriate sporting attire and footwear to maintain the court's condition.
- Footwear that may cause damage to the courts will not be permitted at any time.

- Refrain from consuming alcohol or using any prohibited substances while on club premises.
- Do not engage in any activities that could impair your judgment or performance.
